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the week before gus starts school he practices with his toys studying clouds reading books and cooking mud pies

froggy's mother knows that everyone's nervous on the first day of school not me says froggy and together they leapfrog to the bus stop flop flop flop froggy's exuberant antics will delight his many fans and reassure them that school can be fun this is a great read aloud with sounds and words that encourage active participation a charming story to calm those pre school jitters school library journal

during parents week at robin hill school the students are all impressed with what one another's parents do for a living especially ayanna who realizes that the artwork her father does at home makes him very special

the first day of school is both scary and exciting for otto at first he is very nervous but then he realizes how much fun school can be otto learns all kinds of things how to share his toys how to play games and even how to remember that shoes are for wearing not for eating silly otto todd parr's bold illustrations and simple text are the perfect fit for children just starting their reading journey at the end of the story todd offers a reassuring message to cure those back to school jitters the first day of school is fun and exciting you will meet new friends learn new things and

then you will be really really smart love otto and todd

shows various types of animals at work and training as service show and farm animals concludes that school is something for both animals and children beautifully re illustrated with a fresh and appealing look these beginning to read books foster independent reading and comprehension using high frequency words and repetition readers gain confidence while enjoying stories about everyday life and adventures educator resources include reading reinforcement activities and a word list in the back activities focus on foundational language and reading skills sections include phonological awareness phonics fluency vocabulary and reading comprehension teachers notes available on website

spot s first day at school turns out to be an exciting adventure the perfect tool for parents introducing children to the concept and fun that is school

on the first day of school grover tries to please everyone but himself in order to make new friends

ming goes to school where she learns to say hello and good bye she meets new friends and introduces them to old friends including her favorite teddy she builds sandcastles and makes snow angels she traces glitters and glues she is so fearless that when held at sword point she even walks the plank and when she s playing in the mud she reaches out and touches the worms with her bare hands but despite those brave deeds she isn t quite ready for the big red slide not yet this is a very sweet story with soft evocative watercolor illustrations that will help kids to grow comfortable with the idea of starting preschool ming is curious and playful and ready for adventure but even she gets scared of new things sometimes kids will relate to her desires and fears and will be excited to see ming at the top of the slide by the story s end a quiet and reassuring picture book for preschoolers 3 5 this is a wonderful going to school story that can be read both at home and in the classroom or childcare center the illustrations provide a lot of diversity of characters making this feel like any classroom in any school in the country

introduces readers to henry s day at school discusses the concept of school community by showing henry with the school s custodian the principal the school nurse and others additional features to aid comprehension include vivid photographs extended learning activities a phonetic glossary and sources for further research

dora and boots help their teacher maestra beatriz get to school on time when her bicycle gets a flat tire

in the jack and jillian book series jack and jillian write about learning new things when jack goes to school he writes about his first day back to school and his experiences during the day the book is intended to make students feel comfortable and excited about learning different educational subjects recess and lunchtime interacting and getting along with other students the book also addresses bullying and the importance of facing the challenges students have in today s classrooms the jack and jillian book series are aimed at encouraging challenging young minds and motivating them to remain active both physically and mentally recommended for children 4 to 8

get your preschooler and kindergartener school ready with bestselling lola as she heads to her first day of school a comforting and cheerful picture book read that explores the school day and it s new routine for first time students lola and her family prepare for the first day of school the night before then wake up early take pictures and head to class lola puts her things in her cubby chooses her activities reads plays and has a snack before she knows it it s time to sing the good bye song and rush into mommy s arms for a warm reunion a new sweet adventure from the lola reads series to help the littlest students understand just how fun school can be

during his day at school max listens to and writes a story plays on the playground and eats lunch

morris the moose can t read or count so he decides to go to school after a day of abcs and 123s morris is thrilled with all that he has learned this classic silly level one i can read is perfect for shared reading with a child for fans of danny and the dinosaur sammy the seal or anyone who loves to read silly stories about animals

karson goes to school is a story about what it is like for a student s first day in first grade it is told from the memory of our hero the young karson who happens to have adhd it is full of fears and hopes and friends and embarrassment

giddy gilbert goes to school is a fun fiction children s picture book with action words that grab the reader s attention it is a great book for both nonreaders and beginning readers giddy gilbert is experiencing anxiety about going to school his mother tries to calm him by telling him how exciting and fun school is once giddy gilbert gets to school to his great surprise he makes friends and really enjoys school giddy gilbert is learning lots of new things at school and making many friends he even loves his teacher at the end of the first day giddy gilbert worries about telling mama that he really wants to go back to school this book is full of puns humor and colorful characters it is an original and hilarious this is a book about the experiences of a child entering school for the first time and how he or she feels about change friendships and learning taking on a difficult but important part of children s lives linda ellis lee gives readers a way to experience and discuss their fears in a safe and comforting way

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
